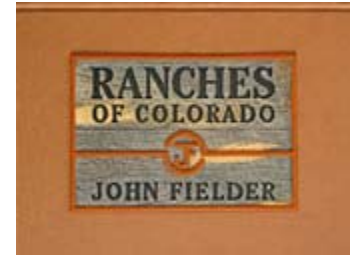


## A PARTNERSHIP TO SAVE MORE LAND

Stunning ranch landscapes from every corner of Colorado – from the eastern plains to the high mountain valleys and west slope river canyons – have been captured by Fielder's large format camera. Additionally, journalist James Meadow has interviewed ranchers spotlighted in the book and written a dozen essays recounting the history of these ranch families and their relationship with the land.

With this book, John's long-standing passion for the land has been translated into action. As part of his commitment to land conservation, he has agreed to donate a portion of the royalties to Colorado Open Lands and our partners, CCALT and CCLT.
